



'Where Does O D Negative Go': Audit Report Highlight Summary



Who used them?

Total units transfused (n=405) by clinical specialty:

13 O- units were used in Obstetrics and 22 in 'other' specialties.



Emergency units issued (n=52):




to Females <50 years

Age of standard[†] units (n=465) at the point of issue from Welsh Blood Service [WBS] (†excludes irradiated).



Key messages

- 49.6% went to O- patients –this rises to 56.7% (n=289) with transferred units: this is consistent with audit data from 2018.
- 3x more emergency units went to females than males, in keeping with practice advocated in the BHNOG O D negative guidance.

<u>Next steps</u> Alongside the full All Wales report for this audit, individual Health Board reports are being generated to facilitate developing action plans which will:

- o focus on positive messages and address shortfalls,
- o have defined timelines for completion,
- o be reviewed by HTCs to reinforce good practice and improvements,
- be communicated widely throughout clinical areas to encourage appropriate use in practice.
