

PRE-OP ANAEMIA SERVICE IMPROVEMENTS AT ABUHB

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WHERE WE STARTED BEFORE VBHC FUNDING

- No formal route to provide IV iron from PAC
- Patchy IV iron provision (colorectal cancers vs other areas)
- Nil data capture on patients having IV iron.
- No POAS testing
- No PROMS and no PREMS for IV iron.
- No template letters for oral or IV iron to patients or GPs.

PAC IV IRON

• Over 100 patients treated since Jan 2024 in the OTU who would not have been able to access IV iron before the VBHC funding.

Paper prescriptions at launch . . .

Sources of stress for OTU nurses and anaesthetic admin staff.

PAC IV IRON DIGITAL

- PAC IV iron is now digitally prescribed within the same e form as the referral.
- Record of IV iron is made on CWS (clinical workstation) by OTU and other groups.
- Zero paper, better governance and traceability.
- Nurses and anaesthetic admin staff much happier.
- Patient waiting time reduced. (Prescription and pharmacy dispensing time)

CHANGES AND IMPROVEMENTS

Patient care and experience

- All PAC and ortho PAC patients have the option of IV iron if appropriate.
- IV iron now kept in OPD so no more trips to pharmacy.
- Patients needing consultant PAC and IV iron usually offered single visit to RGH for both where possible.


CHANGES AND IMPROVEMENTS

Digital measures and process improvements

- Digital IV iron prescriptions.
- Digital record keeping by nursing staff administering IV iron.
- Template letters for GPs and patients including full ABUHB consent form for Ferric Derisomaltose.
- DHCW data submission pilot contributor.

CHANGES AND IMPROVEMENTS

Staff training and governance

- PAC and ortho PAC nurses have been given training on IV iron indications.
- Rewrite of the ABUHB pre op anaemia guidance to SOP approved by clinical policies group and now in use.
- Dr Cath Jenkins has completed and had a PGD for oral iron in PAC approved by clinical policies group. (This is to be rolled out after major PAC structural changes are complete.)
- PREM forms now being sent out and are live.
- PROM forms designed and planned to go live in next few months after IT platform has changed.

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
Pre-Op Anaemia - IV Iron Infusion Clinic Feedback






